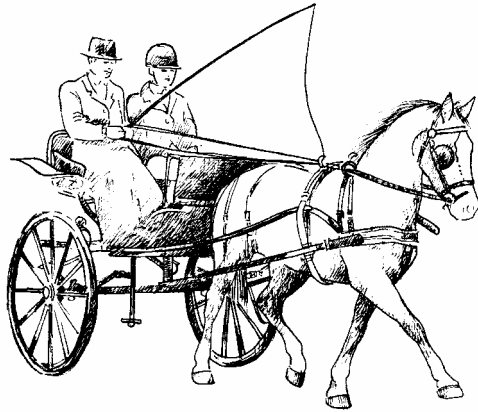

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries close on Wednesday June 27th 2012.
2. Late entries will be charged double fees for all classes unless another class has been previously entered.
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. The Organisers accept no liability for any damage to competitors, officials or property. This is a condition of entry.
5. We reserve the right to cancel classes if insufficient entries are received by the official closing date.
6. Young drivers 18 years and under must be accompanied by a competent adult at all times when driving. Rosettes for the highest placed young driver will be awarded in every class.
7. All sections 4 years old or over to be driven to a suitable vehicle (commercial vehicles barred). A highest place Junior whip rosette will be awarded in all classes.
8. Please indicate on entry form if you are a Junior of 18 years and under.
9. Driving members of any RDA Group are welcome to enter any of Classes 1-5. The RDA will award a rosette to the highest placed member in each class, in addition to the Show's rosettes.

RING 1 (starting at 9:30am)

- Class 1 Pleasure Driving** £7.00
For non-traditional and exercise vehicles (pneumatic tyres allowed). Horse or pony 4 years or over. This class will be divided if entries warrant. Prize to highest placed Junior whip.
To be judged on safety, cleanliness of horse/pony and vehicle, and obedience of animal, also on ability and turnout of the whip. Neither animal nor whip should have won more than £30 in the previous year.
- Class 2 Exercise vehicles - Singles (any height). This class has one O&R Qualifier.** £7.00
Driven in a non-traditional-type vehicle (pneumatic tyres permitted). To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout and correct fitting of harness. **There are two Young Driver qualifiers with this class.**
- Class 3 Open Lady Whip driving any vehicle.** £7.00
Judged on driving ability and suitability of turnout for a lady to drive.
- Class 4 Coloured Horse/Pony single or multiple** £7.00
Open to horses and ponies of any height, 4 years and over, piebald, skewbald, spotted animal driven to any vehicle. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and suitability of horse and pony.
- Class 5 Concours d'Elegance** £7.00
For competitors in Classes 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Championship for first and second prize-winners in classes 1, 2, 3, and 4.

LUNCH-BREAK

At 1:30pm approximately:

- Class 6 Concours d'Elegance** £7.00
Private driving class without a road-drive for Classes 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.
- Class 7 Light Trade. This class has two OR Qualifiers. (See below for details.)** £7.00
A single or pair of horses/ponies to be shown in a trade vehicle. No goods to be carried.
- Class 8 Singles 13.2hh and under. This class has OR Open Qualifiers. (See below for details.)** £7.00
- Class 9 Singles of over 13.2hh. This class has OR Open Qualifiers. See below for details.)** £7.00
- Class 10 Pairs and tandems - open any height. This class has an OR Open Qualifier. (See below.)** £7.00

Championship for first and second prize-winners in classes 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Osborne Refrigerators Championship

Classes Nos. 2, 7, 8, 9 and 10 are qualifiers for the 2012 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Section/s disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place (10th place for Sections o-r as below) in the class will qualify for the 2012 Semi-Finals. The Championship will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

Type-sections:

f – Single pure-bred registered Welsh ponies – Section C

g – Single pure-bred registered Welsh ponies – Sections A and B

h – Single registered Mountain & Moorland (excluding pure-bred registered Welsh)

i – Pairs and tandems - open - any height

j – Two-wheel light trade

k – Four-wheel light trade

l – Single turnout driven to a two-wheel exercise vehicle

q – Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 10-14 years

r – Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 15-17 years
